





# How the school works


- We are a public school. The school isn't really divided into sections like primary school and secondary school. We are one big school and we are all at the same place.
- In 7<sup>th</sup> grade we are at school from 8.00 to 15.00 normally.
- Every Thursday we have "flexdag". That's where we have the same subject all day in 8 lessons. In 7<sup>th</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup> grade we also have a special subject we choose our self. This is typical more creative subjects like cooking class, art, moviemaking and global perspective.
- We don't wear school uniforms and there is no dress code at all.



# Traditions



- We have a yearly spring concert where the classes are playing music pieces that they have practised on. There is also small shops where the students are selling their homemade projects.
- The older students (7<sup>th</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup> grade) have a sort of prom. The 9<sup>th</sup> graders perform the folkdance les lanciers. We dance and have fun.
- Then we one time a year have a project week where we the last years have focused on the climate and the 17 global goals.
- Each year when the 9<sup>th</sup> grade are graduate we celebrate it with them throwing caramels in the schoolyard where everyone else are and trying to grab the caramels.
- And every Christmas the whole school go to church. It's a Protestantism church.





# Food



- On our school we have a foodservice which name is 'EAT'. There you can “book” food for the days you want. You go to the website and choose which food you want to eat. There is 3 choices each day. Two warm dishes and a cold sandwich.
- If you don't want to buy food you can also bring your own food. You can take every kind of food you want to. There is no rules. You can also go out in the breaks and buy food. But that's only the 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> grades.



# International profile school

- We are an international school. That means that we have more language in school. We also start from 1th grade with English. We also have Cambridge as a subject of choice, which is a subject in English with focus on the climate and math. If you complete the subject, you will get a Cambridge diplomate.
- We also have a partnership with a class in Sweden. But its not every class that have got a partnership with a other class. But some have and then the classes have to travel and work with the Swedish students.

# How do we focus on the climate
